

In conclusion, BTP Expo is a major event in the construction industry in Morocco, offering a unique opportunity to discover the latest innovations and meet industry experts.




BTP EXPO Forum Presentation

Institutionals & Clients

Institutionals & Clients represent public and private entities that finance and commission construction and public works projects. This includes local authorities, ministries, federations, development agencies, private companies, etc. This sector is an essential link in the production chain in the construction and public works field, as it determines the needs and budgets allocated to construction projects.



Construction Companies

Construction companies are the key actors involved in implementing construction and public works projects. They carry out various tasks related to construction, including building erection, infrastructure development, and project management.



Carpentry & Closure

Electrical Equipment and Integrated Systems

The Electrical Equipment and Integrated Systems sector encompasses all the electrical equipment and systems used in buildings and structures. This includes electrical distribution equipment, lighting systems, heating, ventilation, air conditioning (HVAC) systems, security and access control systems, communication systems, etc. This sector is constantly evolving, with the introduction of new technologies and intelligent management systems to optimize energy efficiency and user comfort.



Construction Machinery and Equipment

This sector includes actors who design, manufacture, and market equipment and machinery for construction and public works.
