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#### Abstract

It must contain a succinct discussion of the purpose of the research, problem, method/approach, principal results, major conclusions and future/potential application of the work. References and non-standard or uncommon abbreviations should be avoided, and abbreviations should be defined the first time they are used. It should not exceed 250 words, and it should be written in English following the standard rules of grammar.

# VI. Presentation (MAX OF 10 PRESENTATIONS PER TRACK)

- The total duration of the presentation is 15 mins. Ten (10) mins will be allotted for the presentation and and 5 mins for Q & A.
- The onsite and online presentations will be combined. The sequence of the presentation will be revealed through the official program.
- The presentation file (PowerPoint) for onsite presenters and the recorded video for the online presenters should be uploaded to the corresponding Google Drive prepared by the conference organizer on or before March 11, 2024.

- The file should be labeled with this format: Track Number\_Last Name of the Main Author (e.g. Track 1 Smith).
- The contents of the presentation should include: Title, Introduction, Methodology, Results & Discussion, Conclusions, and Recommendations.
- During the presentation, presenters' attire, clarity, confidence, and rapport should be also emphasized.
- After the presentation, the onsite presenter must stay and the online presenter must be virtually present to answer the questions from the panel of judges.

## VII. Poster Presentation

- Only onsite participants can join the poster presentation. There will be an allotted room for the exhibit of posters.
- The poster must be in portrait orientation with these dimensions: Width-60 cm; Length 160 cm.
- The standee should be provided by the authors.
- The contents of the poster should include: Title, Name of authors and Affiliation, Abstract, Introduction, Objectives, Methodology, Results & Discussion, Conclusions, and Recommendation.
- The presentation of visuals like graphs, tables, figures, pictures, or diagrams must be clear and organized.

# VIII. Awards/Recognition

Based on the marks given by evaluation committee, the session chair declares which presentation will receive the Best Presentation Award (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>), and Best Poster Award (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>) for EACH TRACK. The following are the criteria set of each of the awards:
