2024 Summer Semester Course Descriptions

FCM 104 – Old Testament Survey, Part 2 – Mondays, June 10 through August 26, 7:00 to 9:00 pm. Foundation Certificate Level – Pre-requisite: FCM 103 – Old Testament Survey, Part 1

A continuation of the sweeping overview of God's working. The Message of the books of poetry and prophecy gives insight into God's dealings with His people. This course relates the great writings of the prophets to us today. End time prophecies abound! The course is arranged in chronological sequence to avoid duplication of historical background information. Author: Garnett Reid, ISBN 978-0-910-566-47-6. Instructor: Minister Preston Jordan.

SCM 204 – Beyond Reasonable Doubt – Mondays, June 10 through August 26, 7:00 to 9:00 pm. Standard Certificate Level – Pre-requisites: None.

Aside from personal faith in God, is there evidence to substantiate the claims of Christianity? You be the judge! An introduction to the study of apologetics, this book will take a step-by-step approach through the well-documented evidence and help you reach a verdict that could change your life. ACM 301 – The Triune God – Tuesdays, June 11 through August 27, 7:00 to 9:00 pm. Advanced Certificate Level- Pre-requisites: None.

This work is a popular presentation addressing the contemporary need for confidence in God: the personality and work of God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit as Trinity. The doctrine of the Trinity is clearly expounded in this timeless treasure from ETA's founder, Clarence H. THE REVELATION OF JESUS CHRIST TO THE APOSTLE JOHN – Thursdays, June 13 through August 29, with July 4th off, 7:00 pm to 9:00 pm.

No book of the Bible has evoked greater fascination or led to more controversy than Revelation. Its profound mysteries, elusive symbolism, powerful predictions, and colorful language are unparalleled in the rest of Scripture. Attempts to interpret its details have spanned the extremes from the sublime to the ridiculous. God promises great blessing to those who study the book of Revelation and heed its message. God’s final message to humanity remains clear – in the end good will triumph over evil, wickedness will be judged, and the righteous will receive their rewards. This class will study the book together and the **Bible** will be our primary textbook, preferably the **NASB version**. In addition, we will draw from many notable teachers of prophecy in articles and videos. We also will use a **textbook** as our guide through the adventure: **The Non-Prophet’s Guide to the Book of Revelation**. Author: Todd Hampson, ISBN 978-0-7369-7540-7.
